

Rules and Regulations for the Nordic Co-Production Market 2025

The producer and director should present the selected projects in person during a 7-minute presentation at the Nordic Co-Production Market in Haugesund on Wednesday, 20 August. By 27 July, all visual and written materials for our program catalog and presentation must be submitted to the festival.

Eligible applicants

• All Nordic and Baltic production companies are eligible to apply. Films co-produced with at least one Nordic country and movies with a solid connection to the Nordic countries by story or location are also eligible to apply.

Project criteria

- Full-length cinema feature film
- Suitable for an international co-production
- Completed screenplay in English (preferably)
- Production budget: Moderate
- At least 30 % of the budget already covered (preferably)
- The company must have completed one international coproduction (preferably)

Project Submission

- Fully completed submission form
- Treatment in English (5-12 pages)

Submission deadline 30 April 2025

For selected projects, we offer:

- 2 nights' accommodation for producer and director
- Festival- and market accreditation for producer and director
- Tailored one-on-one meetings with industry professionals
- Description of selected project in program catalog and website
- Access to seminars, workshops and network events
